**HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BASIC ENTRANCE TEST**

In 2006, the programs of Radiography, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Radiation Therapy and Diagnostic Medical Sonography, adopted a policy that ALL candidates for admission to these programs must take an entrance examination prior to acceptance. An applicant will be assigned a test date when the application is received.

The cost of this test is included in your \$100.00 application fee. On the date of the exam, an applicant will need to bring a pen (blue or black ink), two sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers and a photo ID (i.e., driver's license, student ID, permanent resident card). Calculators are not permitted.

**ONLY ASSIGNED APPLICANTS MAY SIT FOR THE EXAM.**

The HOBET evaluates areas that are essential for academic success in medical imaging and therapeutic sciences including basic math skills (and algebra), science reading comprehension, writing and learning styles.

**INTERPRETING YOUR HOBET SCORES:**

- **ESSENTIAL MATH SKILLS** – The average passing Math Skills score is 59; a score of 39 or below is considered a high-risk math score.
- **READING COMPREHENSION** – Applicants should score at the Independent or the Instructional Level of the Reading Comprehension section of the test.
