Registration

- All tuition and fees from previous semesters must be paid in full or you will be unable to register. (If applicable)
- Register online at <http://webservices.ucc.edu>. **Do not pay online to UNION County College.** -When you first sign into Web Advisor at Union: **User Name: firstname.lastname**; **System Password (Case Sensitive): Uccmddy (Birthdate)**; your new password must contain 8 or 9 characters, must contain a Capital letter, lower case letter and a number, you cannot use your name.
- Register at one of the three Union County College campuses.

 1. On-Line E-Services – review your **Degree Audit** for accuracy for course progression and graduation.
 2. Through Online E-Services or Web Services you can view your GPA, grades, transfer credit awarded, **Degree Audit** (to monitor your pre-reqs and co-reqs) and order transcripts.
 3. Returning students who were not enrolled for Spring 2011 semester must fill out another UNION County College application and pay the application fee. This can be done through UNION County College's website.
 4. If you register for NURM119081, then you must also register for NRML119081 or NRML119082. If you register for NURM119085, then you must also register for NRML119086 or NRML119087.
- If your transfer credit has been entered, it will be visible on the Union County College website through Online E-Services – Degree Audit www.ucc.edu.
- UCC101 is required for new high school graduates and students who have had no previous college courses.
- If you have been out of high school for a number of years and feel you need to review your sciences, consider BIO102 (Human Biology) and CHE005 (Intro to Chemistry).
- Map out your course of study by using the curriculum check-off sheet from our school website www.ifkmuhlenbergschools.org within Forms.
- When mapping out your course of study, (6) six credits is half-time and (12) twelve credits is full-time.
- NURM121 evenings is only offered in the Spring semester, so map out NURM119 for the Fall semester.
- Humanity Electives: Refer to the Union County College 2011-2012 Catalog
- Sonography students must have satisfactorily completed the following courses to be eligible for clinical: BIO105, ENG101, MAT119, PSY101 or SOC101, DMSM101 and PHY125 w/lab or PHY101 w/lab.
- Union County College Application: A new application must be completed if you were not enrolled for classes for one or more semesters. Application and fee, are required, input the application through Union's website.
